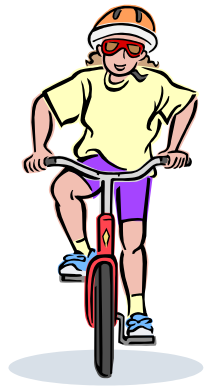


# The Co-Parenting Class

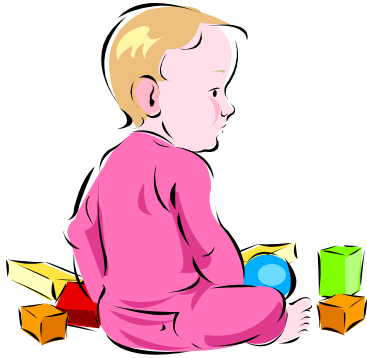
## Who Should Attend?

- ◆ **All parents**, whether married or never married, who are separating and/or divorcing.
- ◆ **All parents** who become involved in the Court system (*it is mandatory by local rule of court*).
- ◆ **Other** family members, interested parties, friends and future prospective parents.

## Why Is This Important?

The separation/divorce rate is so prevalent in our society it will affect the lives of millions of children. Research indicates that separation and divorce can have a negative impact on children. Information related to the effect of separation/divorce on children and on the effectiveness of co-parenting can minimize the extent to which children may be at risk and enhance their adjustment.

## Focus: The needs of the Children



- ◆ Learn how to reduce parental conflict.
- ◆ Listen to children's experience of their parent's divorce.
- ◆ Consider different post-separation parenting relationships.
- ◆ Enhance your child/children's adjustment to parental separation or divorce through improved co-parenting.
- ◆ Keep children out of the middle and protect them from parental conflict.
